We have received no complaints, or contact on that pager, about newspaper behaviour on the Tim Toulmin day. Indeed, it was notable that we received no complaints of harassment or intrusion after the bombings themselves last year.

I would be grateful if you could let me know whether there were any issues relating to press conduct that arose on the day of the anniversary. Any information would be useful for the PCC for future reference.


