It was a pleasure to meet you recently at the News Corporation party, and I was very pleased to see that you had been appointed Secretary of State. Many congratulations.

The PCC has been grateful for the government's support for press self-regulation over the years, something that we hope will continue. There are currently a number of challenges for media regulators posed by new technologies and convergence. We think that the PCC's structure and approach – flexibility, independence, the cooperation of the regulated industry, and the application of principles rather than prescriptive rules - are well suited to the new landscape.

We have also entrenched several reforms to the PCC over the last few years in order to guarantee transparency and accountability, which I hope has led to greater trust in the Commission's work.

I would welcome the opportunity to brief you on these issues and also to hear your own views. I know you will be very busy but I wonder whether you — and any of your officials or ministerial colleagues, if appropriate — might be free some time in the autumn for a private dinner with me and the Commission's Director, Tim Toulmin.
