It was very good to see you at the meeting at Reuters on Tuesday.

I thought you might like to see some further documents which expand on what we were discussing. The PCC's submission to the Select Committee goes into some considerable detail on what we do to protect privacy – from regulating newsgathering methods to offering a range of remedies when things go wrong – and it also sets out our approach to online regulation. I am also enclosing our report into subterfuge which followed an investigation after the Goodman/Mulcaire convictions and the resignation of the News of the World's editor.

Finally, I thought you might like a copy of a new wallet-sized leaflet that we have just published. It is designed to provide a brief check list of our services, along with all our contact details so that people can get in touch with us at any time if a problem arises.
